COMMANDS

Server Commands

-buff	Applies several buff spells to your character. Must be level 45.
-dmg [on/off]	Toggles damage messages on or off.
-drop [all mine party] [on/off]	Toggles drop messages on or off.
-help	A list of server commands
-potion [on/off]	Toggles potion messages on or off.
-warp 1-12	Used to teleport to a location. Typing just -warp without a number will give you the following menu: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Pandora NPC 2. Silver Knight Town (SKT) 3. Giran Town 4. Werldern Town 5. Oren Town 6. Orc Town 7. Silent Cavern (DE Town) 8. Gludio Town 9. Silveria Town 10. Behimous Town 11. CoD 12. Twisting of Space
.uptime	See how long the server has been up since last reset.

Helpful Commands

/bookmark OR /bookmark [Name]	Allows player to bookmark a location to access again using a Ring of Teleport Control (ROTC), Elf (level 50+) Controlled Teleport setting, or Blessed Teleport Scroll.
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/invite	Invites a player to a party.
/party	Shows party members.
.reload	Use .reload to refresh screen when mops/pets are stuck.

Chat & Social Commands

@[Text]	Use the @ sign to send a message to your pledge.
&[Text]	Use the & sign to send a global message.
#[Text]	Use the # sign to send a party message.
"[Player Name] [Text]	Use " followed by the player name to send a private message (whisper)
/exclude [Player Name]	Use /exclude to block a player and no longer see their messages.
/who [Player Name]	If the player is online, will display their name and their pledge. Will also show how many players are online.
/exchange	When facing the other player, will initiate a trade request that can be accepted or declined.
/addfriend [Player Name]	Add player to your friends list.
/friend	View friends list

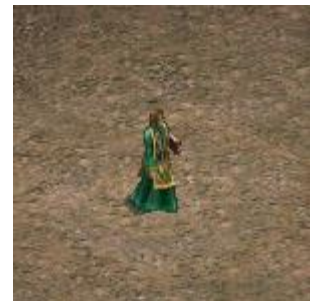
/deletefriend [Player Name]	Removes friend from friends list
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Pledge Commands

/create [Name]	Allows prince(ss) to create pledge.
/emblem [Pledge Name] [on / off]	
/join	When facing the prince of a pledge, /join will allow them to accept you.
/leave	Quits the pledge that you are a member of.
/pledge	See online pledge members.
/title [Player Name] [Title]	Allows prince to assign a title to player over level 40.
/war [Pledge Name]	Declares war on a enemy pledge. /surrender is used to end the war, and /cease is used to try to end a war with a truce.

ALCHEMIST

Players earn necessary supplies such as Magic Gems and Spirit Gems by trading in Relics to the Alchemist in every town. Relics are earned from multiple mops.

FOOD

Food can be purchased in the Market by vendors in the center (Fantasy), North, and South corners of town. **Note:** Fantasy adds +5 damage reduction making it ideal for PVP.

DOLLS

Dolls are helpful tools that provide a player with additional benefits ranging from increased damage to regenerating mana. One doll may be summoned at a time and are not reliant on CHA. Unlike pets or summons, they cannot be commanded by the player.



Doll Effects





Dolls last 30 minutes when summoned and must be re-summoned if the player dies. Here are the effects of each main doll:

	Bugbear: Reduces weight by 10%
	Werewolf or Crustacean: 3% chance of +15 damage for melee characters.
	Elder or Succubus: Regenerate 15 MP every minute.
	Stone Golem: A 4% chance of absorbing 15 damage.
	Yeti: Offers +5 freeze resistance and -1 AC
	Cockatrice: Increase ranged accuracy and ranged damage both by +1.
	Spartoi: +3 damage reduction Note: Purchased with 2,500 Feathers
	Ramia: +5 mp regeneration & poisons target on attack. Note: Purchased with 2,500 Feathers
	Scarecrow: +2 melee accuracy, +2 ranged accuracy, +2 ranged damage

Note: Purchased with 5,000 Feathers

Event Dolls

Because of the powerful benefit of these dolls, they are only available during a server event:

	Green Snowman: +1 all stats, +2 ranged accuracy, +2 ranged damage
	Red Snowman: +10% exp, +50 hp, 4% chance to absorb 15 damage
	Blue Snowman: +50 mp, +20 mp regeneration
	Gold Snowman: +10% exp, +1 all stats, +5 mp regeneration

Creating a Doll

In order to create a random doll, players can complete a quest by turning in quest items to the NPC Aruca in Gludio (-warp 8). The items needed are a Skeleton Grail, Rare Turtle, Spice of the Castle Chef, and Seal of Victory.

These items can be earned by [completing these steps](#), or bought by the merchant Luth in Gludio for 11.8m each. **Note:** Players can purchase fantasy food from the Food Merchant in the center of the Market.

Summoning a Doll



In order to summon a doll, player must use a specific crystal that is made by dissolving items in solvent.

Solvent can be bought from Diad Village (use Teleport Lady to tele there) from an NPC named Emart. Once you have solvent, double click on it and a junk item to turn it into crystals.

CANDLING

Candling is a process that allows a player to reset all their stats. This is a great way to rest out different builds without having to remake a character.

In order to candle, players should buy the 'Candle of Reminiscence' from the merchant Luth in Gludio (warp 8).

Once a candle is obtained, speak to NPC Lolo in either Gludio town center or the Market to begin the candle process.



BLESSING OF EINHASAD (AFK Experience Boost)

When a player is AFK in town, or offline, they earn The Blessing of Einhasad (up to 200%). This provides players with 177% exp until the buff wears off.



FEATHER SYSTEM

Feathers have the chance to drop from practically all mops (except in special locations such as the Crack of Time or Giran Prison) and can be traded in for various rewards. Clicking on a feather will take you to the special town with multiple vendors offering different rewards.

MELISSA

Melissa is everyone's favorite man/woman/them/non-binary tele scroll seller. Melissa is located in Aden near the top-center of town. **You can get teleport scrolls/potions for the following locations:**



- Lastavard 1f & 2f
- Pirate Island
- Heine Dungeon Underwater
- Dream Island
- Forgotten Island
- Beleth
- TOI 10f
- TOI 20f
- TOI 30f
- Abyss Lake
- Ant Cave 3f

Tip: Melissa is also the only NPC that buys Elf Spirit Crystals!

MARKET

The Market is a place where players (and a few NPC's) setup shops to buy/sell from other players. To setup a shop, use the command **/shop** to add items and set prices. Two lines underneath the 'Buying Item' section allow you to add a message for players to see letting them know what you buy/sell.



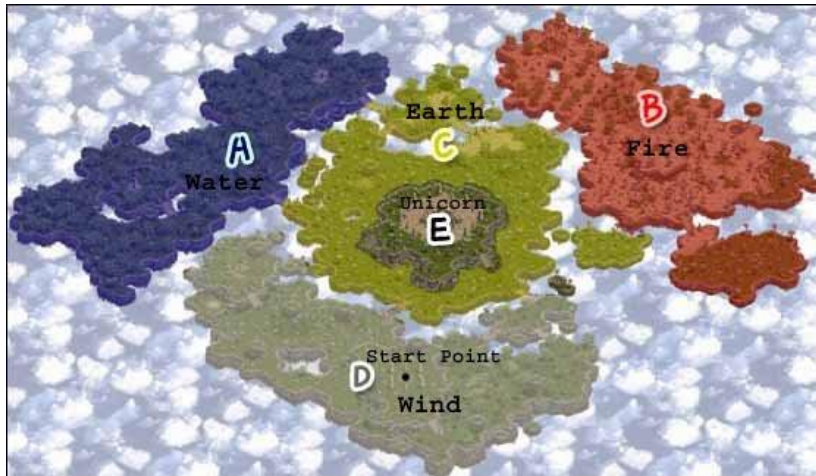
ELIXIRS

Elixirs allow a player to increase a stat by 1 and can be obtained from Dream Island. While the Elixirs are for one of the six stats, players are able to apply the point to any non-maxed stat during the candling process.

Elixirs have a low chance to drop from any monster on Dream Island, with the highest chance rate with the island's bosses: Great Spirits of Wind/Fire/Water/Earth or Unicorn.

Most players seem to have the most luck in the 'Water' area of Dream Island, and the mops can be easily killed (Ice Golems, Iceman, Will O' Wisps).

Access Dream Island from either a scroll from Melissa, or using the Teleport NPC in 'Gypsy Town' just north of Aden.



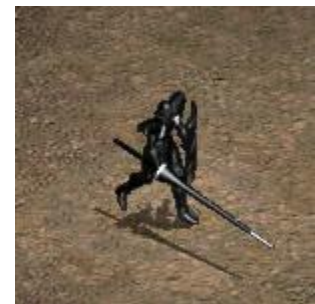

FARMING

There are two player-recommended areas to farm for adena: Training Dungeon (4f) and Black Knights around Silver Knight's Town (SKT). Both areas drop items that can be sold to an NPC for adena.

The Training Dungeon 4f: Bugbears, King Bugbears, and Cerberus that drop Staff of Sorcery, Banded Mail, Great Axes, and armor or weapon enchant scrolls that can all be sold to Pandora at -warp 1.



Black Knights: Drops t-shirts, gems, plate mail, cloaks of protection



To access the Training Dungeon 4f, follow the prompts from a town teleporter: *"I'd like to have a hunting ground guide."* > *Level 36 ~ 40 Hunting Grounds* > *"Please tell me about easier places."* > *The 4th Floor of the Training Dungeon.*

GAMBLING

There are two great NPC's that allow you to gamble when you have extra cash / gemstones.

	<p>Karif: Found in Werldern (-warp 4), Karif allows you to trade your regular and high-quality gemstones for pouches. Pouches contain multiple different pots and ingredients, with the best item being dragon scales.</p>
	<p>Franko: Found in Oren (-warp 5), Franko sells different armor and weapons that may already be + enchanted. Most players gamble Helmet of Magic Resistance as these can sell for a lot of adena!</p>

PLACES TO LEVEL

Tower of Insolence (TOI): The Tower of Insolence contains 100 floors ranging in difficulty rating and mops with bosses spawning every 10th floor (10f, 20f, 30f, etc.). To move up in floors, players can utilize stairs every 1st – 10th floors but must use a scroll to access the next floor. For example, players can work up from 41f to 50f, but must use a scroll to access 51f.

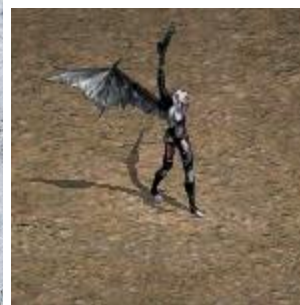
Scrolls drop from the monsters on each floor to move up through TOI.

Giran Prison (GP): Giran Prison has the highest XP in the game, however players are prone to attack from other players. Players only have daily access for 90 minutes.

To access GP, go to **Wizard Merlin NPC** in Giran Town Center (-warp 3). Go through prompts and select "Please send me to prison". There are 4 floors with varying levels of difficulty. When damaged, Giran Bandit mops will transform into Evil Spirits which hit harder.



Twisting of Space (TOS): Use -warp 12 and select the second option from the teleport portal. This location has been boosted for increased exp. Monsters here cast magic, so magic resistance is recommended.



CRACK OF TIME - THEBES AND TIKAL

The Crack of Time refers to special maps that open up four times a day for 3 hours each time, unless the boss is defeated within the timeframe in which the portal will

stay open for 24 hours. The portal to these maps will open in one of nine locations randomly. The portal opening and closing is announced on the LJ Discord.

Fragment of Time



Players collect an item called ‘Fragment of Time’ in the Crack of Time which allows them to open treasure boxes containing special armor and weapons. Once a user collects 100 fragments, they can turn them into the special golem in Tikal and Thebes maps for a ‘Cracked Nucleus’ – the key to the boxes.

Treasure Boxes



Both Thebes and Tikal maps have top and bottom specialty box pieces that a player must combine to be opened with a Cracked Nucleus. Each map has two qualities of boxes – High Grade and Low Grade. Obviously the High Grade yields the highest chance of gaining a weapon or armor piece, however the chance rate of both boxes is low.

Tikal Calendar



An item called the ‘Tikal Calendar’ that can be gained from the Ivory Tower NPC in the Tikal Map (near the oasis close to the entrance) allows you to check to see if the Crack of Time (for either Thebes or Tikal) is open or closed at the time. Simply talk to the NPC and he will provide you with the calendar.

Locations

Players should bookmark the locations of the portal (except one in Twilight Mountains that cannot be bookmarked). Use the **/loc** command to see your current coordinates. [Maps can be found here!](#)

LASTAVARD / LASTABAD



Lastavard (or Lastabad) are the four floors of the Dark Elf episode with varying levels of difficulty. Each floor contains several rooms with swarms of mops that have the chance to drop 'evidence boxes'. These boxes have a small % chance of containing different armor pieces to create sets such as the Pretender King and Arcane King sets.

It is important to note that different mops/areas drop different evidence boxes, so you must hunt in the correct places if you are trying to build a set.
